

## NH's Mountain View Grand Gets Green Power Honor

WHITEFIELD, N.H. (AP) — New Hampshire's Mountain View Grand Resort has been designated a 100 percent green power purchaser by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

The Whitefield resort is the only hotel and one of only five companies in New Hampshire that buys green power to meet all its electricity uses.

The resort recently installed a 121-foot wind turbine and buys green energy certificates that represent power that has been produced by green sources.

A resort manager says those steps are equivalent to removing 135 cars from the road or the electricity used by 102 homes in one year. The resort also has started a recycling program, reuses water to irrigate its golf course and grows its own vegetables.
